### *Mrs. Christine Evans - 5th Science, 6th Science & Religion, and 7th Reading*

This is my 10th year at St. Albert and each year is exciting with new students, new classes and new teachers. I'm very hopeful for a great year with everyone and blessed to be a part of a great junior high team. Our year is off to a great start. In 7th grade reading we are learning about plot conflicts, what makes a story exciting to read, and finding themes in all the different books we read.
