Medication Policy

All medications taken at school whether prescription or over-the-counter (Tylenol, Advil, cold medicine, sunscreen), require a medication form signed by a licensed healthcare provider and parent/guardian. This form must be on file in the school office before the medication may be administered. 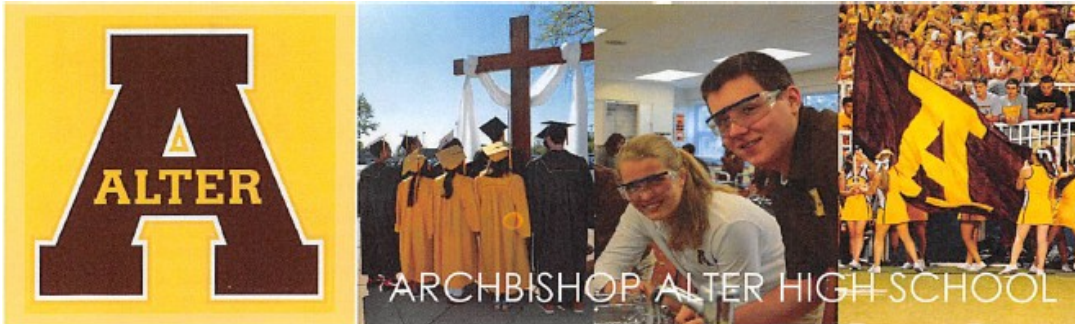
