## Teacher's Corner

### *Mrs. Anna Wasik - Transitional Kindergarten*

We have been very busy in TK for the month of September! The children have been using centers and groups for math, focusing on number sense and counting. We used non-standard units, such as apples and blocks to measure lengths instead of a ruler. We measured our height and different objects that children find in the classroom. The children are practicing forming letters with the Writing Without Tears tools. We made several wonderful classroom books. Every day we sing a phonic song, and so far we covered the letters E, F, H, L and M.

In our Science area, the children are taking care of stuffed animals in our animal hospital, where they give them checkups using Veterinarian tools, filling out forms, looking at X-rays and diagnosing the "sickness." We talked about leaves and why they change color. We also took a nature walk to look for signs of Fall. We picked up leaves and acorns for our science corner. The children used sponges to paint trees representing the four seasons, which you can see outside in the hallway.
