Nurse's Notes

Here are a few reminders from the clinic.... Especially as we enter the dreaded cold and flu season:

If your child has a fever (100.0 or over), or is throwing up, please do not send them to school.

They are to be free of these symptoms for 24 hours before they can return to school. This should be determined without the use of a fever reducing medication such as Tylenol/Advil

No medication may be brought into school without permission from a licensed medical personnel and parent permission. I have the forms in the clinic if your child needs medicine at school.

Cough drops may be kept in a ziplock baggie in the clinic with a parent written permission note.

Eating a **healthy** balanced diet which includes plenty of fruits and vegetables, drinking plenty of water and getting a **good night of sleep** is a recipe for a student ready to learn!

Cold Weather Reminders

Reminder that ALL students go out to recess at least one time per day, even in the cold weather. Please help your child dress accordingly. Coat, hat, gloves and snow boots! The only time we have indoor recess is for wet weather (rain or falling heavy snow). The children are outside even in 20 degree weather, so dress them for it!! The classrooms fluctuate in temperature during the cold months when the heat is on. It is best to dress in layers (sweatshirt or sweater).
