Mrs. Ann Harnish - First Grade

Homeroom 12 has been busy during the First Quarter learning how to use the Accelerated Reader program and practicing reading skills. In Science we studied how plants are different from animals, why the seasons change, why leaves appear to change color (we experimented with chlorophyll), and how animals prepare for these natural changes. In October we looked at bats, spiders, and snakes and made models of each. In Religion Class we learned how to pray the Rosary, and we prayed a decade each day in class. In Math we have moved from addition to subtraction and fact families. We have been writing in our journals, and occasionally we have a "published" piece on display in the hallway. One skill that we fine-tune every day is speaking kindly and properly to others. Using correct grammar is very important, and we practice this as well as choosing words that are delivered with consideration. With Jesus as our role model, we try very hard to speak and act with respect. It is my pleasure to be with these loving students. I thank their parents for sending children to school who are ready to learn, and who are enthusiastic, kind, and enjoyable! God bless you.

South Dayton Catholic Knights Boys Lacrosse

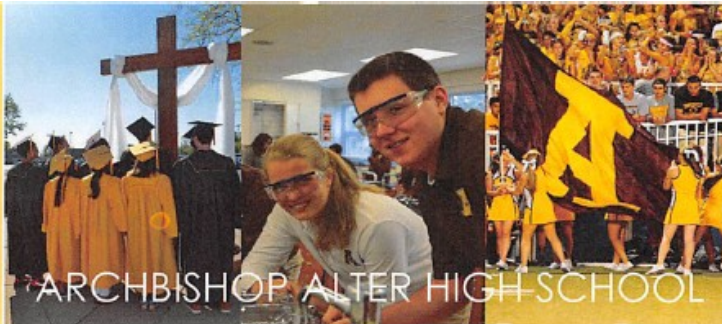

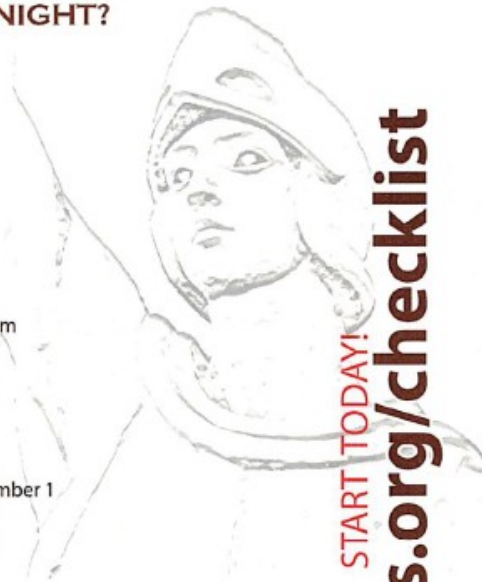
