CYO Volleyball Registration

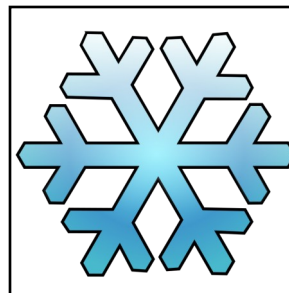
