Teacher's Corner

Mrs. Collette Clayton - 6th, 7th, & 8th Grade

The 7th and 8th grade have been very busy writing in their language arts classes. The 7th grade has been focusing on the 15th anniversary of 9/11. By watching news videos and interviewing an adult who was alive at the time, they were able to gain some background knowledge for their writing piece. Their stories were written in first person and told the story of a child alive on that day involved in one of the three sites of impact; NYC, The Pentagon or in Stonycreek Township, Pennsylvania. The 8th graders stepped outside themselves and wrote in third person to tell Mrs. Clayton about people, places and activities they value in their lives. Their pieces were titled "The Important Piece" based on the Margaret Wise Brown book The Important Book. They also illustrated a puzzle piece which is now hanging in the hallway upstairs in school.

The 6th grade reading class has been working very hard on learning the elements of story plot. We used mentor text by Patricia Polacco to model and demonstrate what we learned. Do you know this famous children author did not learn to read until she was in 5th grade? We learned in Thank you Mr. Falter how Mrs. Polacco overcame bullies and fear to not only learn to read but to flourish into a talented reader and writer. At the resolution of the story, we learned that as an adult Mrs. Polacco was able to thank her 5th grade teacher, Mr. Falker, for spending the extra time with her to help her learn to read.
